

*A Letter To Inmates*  
*Born Again Ministry*

*This letter is for the men who are skeptics and unsure about coming to  
B.A.M.*

*I have been incarcerated and understand your skepticism. I started  
B.A.M. because I knew that there needed to be a place for men to  
transition once being released. I don't want anyone to think that the  
program at B.A.M. will be easy. You will be extremely busy after you  
have completed your month long cool down period. However, you will  
not be under any type of lock-down. Once you arrive, you are a free  
man. If you wake up in the middle of the night and just want some  
fresh air. You can go outside, walk around, and enjoy the night air.  
Just be respectful of the other men in the program.*

*During the building phase of this charity, I will need men like you to  
help shape the classes and programs to ensure the success of everyone.*

*There will be rules that will have to be adhered to!*

*"Zero Tolerance!"*

- 1) No Fighting!*
- 2) No Bullying!*
- 3) No Drugs or Alcohol!*
- 4) No Sexual contact between men in the program!*
- 5) No Pornography!*
- 6) No Stealing!*
- 7) No Damaging or Defacing of anyone's personal  
property or anything owned by B.A.M.*

Here are a few of our plans, so you understand the different ideas and plans I have for you.

Family:

*If you are married and your wife wants to come for a visit, I would like to have housing on property so that she will not have to pay for a hotel while visiting. While she is here, you may stay with her and make love with your wife as God intended.*

Let me make this clear! This is only for legally married couples!

*As long as our funding allows, I will stock the refrigerator in the house your family is staying at so that they will have food to eat. Remember that the restoration of your family is one of our goals.*

*If you are working and earning money with us and our budget allows it, I will "match dollar for dollar only the money you have saved upon your graduation from our program up to \$5,000."*

Let me explain how this works.

*When you enroll in B.A.M., I will set up an account for you. All money you earn will go into this account. You will be given a stipend from the money you earn, so that you have spending money.*

"In order to graduate from our program you must have a minimum of \$5,000 dollars in your account."

*The reason I am doing this is to ensure that you have enough money saved to give you a real chance for success. I understand that you may have to use some of the money you have earned for things like child support or parole fees and other things of this nature. I will be happy to help you deal with these issues. However, understand that it is only the money in your account at the completion of the program and upon graduation, up to \$5,000, that will be matched. This means that you should leave with*

*minimum of \$10,000!*

## The Down Side

*I will be keeping an itemized list of all of our expenses for your transportation, housing, food, clothing etc. If you break one of the "Zero Tolerance" rules, I will bill you for our cost while you were with us. Whatever money remains in your account after we are paid will be given to you. If you have not been with us long enough to earn any money, I will give you a \$100.00 prepaid debit card so that you do not leave our grounds broke. I will also provide a ride for you off of our grounds to the bus station.*

*As long as you follow the rules, you will never be charged for your stay with us while taking the program.*

## Activities

*There are a few other incentives I plan to offer you:*

- *A lake for you and your family to go fishing or canoeing.*
- *A track for walking or riding bicycles.*
- *A trail for riding horses, side by sides, four-wheelers and go-carts.*
- *A swimming pool, lazy river and jacuzzi.*
- *A movie room with an extensive selection of movies.*
- *A game room with billiards tables and ping-pong tables*
- *A basketball, volleyball, and handball court.*
- *A horseshoe and washers pit.*

*There are so many things that you missed out on while incarcerated, so I want there to be enough things to keep you excited about being in the program. Were not done, though.*

*I plan to have enough land so that if you like to hunt, you can go out to one of the many hunting blinds or stands we have set up and bow hunt. The men can use the meat from the deer, turkey, hog, rabbit, squirrel they kill to feed themselves and the men at the program or send the meat home to feed their families.*

*There will be a secondary lake that will be used as a fish farm. We will use the fish to help feed us and sell to raise money. There will be a thrift store we will use to sell donated items such as clothing, appliances, furniture, dishes, toys, shoes, and books.*

*The list of things to do in your free time is extensive. The reason for this is so that you always have something fun to do. Please remember that an idle mind is the devil's playground.*
